Please be advised that I act on behalf of the Nation of the Amikwa Nipissing Allies (NANA). Please find attached a Declaration from NANA which is directed to your governance structure. Section 9 of the British North America Act, 1867, states: "The Executive Government and Authority of and over Canada is hereby declared to continue and be vested in the Queen (King). The Honour of the Crown flows downward from the King.

The Amikwa (Amik-Beaver) (Beaver Nation) and Nipissing assert original title to lands in Ontario and Quebec. NANA is not extinct, not under the apartheid system of the Indian Act and continues to be misidentified by governments at all levels – British Crown, Federal Government, Provincial Government and Municipal Government.

NANA draws upon the governance of the Elders in Order to practice their laws, traditions, customs and ceremonies on an equal footing to the laws of Britain and the territory known as Canada.

The Common Law system defines the relationship between the indigenous and the Crown as sui generis. "Sui generis is defined as a Latin term for meaning "of its own kind," used to describe something unique that does not fit into existing legal classifications."

NANA calls upon the Crown, in its various incarnations, to fulfill its obligations defined as Honour of the Crown and immediately consult and accommodate NANA upon its assertion of original title.
